I have learned that the ballots have been sent to the printers without affording all candidates the chance to examine them for errors. I also have learned that the incumbents did not comply with the 100-signature requirement imposed on challenger candidates. This is in violation of the Homes Association's own resolution. Moreover, this is in contradiction to your representation to the Court in chambers that the incumbents would submit 100 signatures as a condition to appearing on the ballot. Mr. Schott requests that you notify the Court that your prior representation was inaccurate.
